G. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT – Dr. Varley reported on the following

 process of the challenge and announced the winners. Mr. Christ recognized Mrs. Abdy for
 her initiation of the program as well as being nominated by BASF to represent them this year
 at the National Event. The following students were recognized; Philip Mascaro, Nicholas
 Rauschenberger, Daniel Gore, George Flanagan, Eric Schulman, Andrew Modrowsky and
 Cooper Takach. Nicholas Rauschenberger will be competing at the National level in
 Philadelphia.
- William Paterson "MED in Educational Leadership and Academic Excellence" Award Dr. Caponegro provided a brief background and introduced this years recipient- Mr. Jeremy Serfozo
- Morris County School Boards Association President Presentation Mrs. Karen Cortellino,
 President provided her personal experience as a school board member and outlined various
 programs and initiatives being conducted on the county level.

I. COMMITTEE REPORTS

Policy- Mrs. Thomas stated the committee met on 5/17/16 to discuss many policies on the agenda this evening.

Curriculum- Mrs. Haynes stated the committee met on 5/16/16. The committee discussed the Long Range Curriculum matrix, FY17 curriculum council positions, the National Spelling Bee, Evaluation

Models for both teachers and administrators and the need to examine the value of iReady as compared to similar programs used in high performing districts.

Personnel- Mrs. Thomas stated the committee met on 5/17/16 as well to discuss summer enrichment and various ESY16 positions, Supervisor of ELA process and qualifications, the resignation of Mrs. Monteleone, she will be missed. The committee reviewed the contracts for FY17 for Mr. Stiles and Mr. Infantolino. The committee spent time with Mrs. Hawkins reviewing her goals for the special education programs and programs in general for FY17. Mrs. Hawkins proposed creating a substantive parent led advisory group. Mrs. Hawkins collaborating with Miss Conroy will pilot "Yoga 4 Classrooms" which was well received by Mr. Shanley and the committee as this was a recent topic discussed at a NJSBA workshop dealing with stress/anxiety in the classroom. The final area of focus will be co-teaching and the evaluation of the special education teacher.

Finance/Facility- Mrs. Heinold stated the committee met on 5/3, 5/10, 5/17 and 5/18. The first three dates were to review Policies 7000 and 8000. The last date was to conduct regular business, which included the April financial reports, the NJSIG grant application, district water testing, New Horizons summer facility use and reimbursement for hydraulic fluid spill by Morris County. The committee spent time discussing renovation to Briarwood kitchen now that the PTA has selected a vendor. Transportation – Mrs. Haynes stated the committee met on 5/18 to discuss driver evaluations and vehicle inspections. The misconduct log was reviewed. Some entries in the log are missing how the write up was addressed.

H.P.R.H.S Articulation- Mrs Haynes reviewed various items discussed at the recent board meeting. Teacher Administrator Board- Mrs. Heinold stated the committee met on 5/5/16. Mrs. Hausman stated the BSI program at Briarwood is making progress. BSI at Brooklake is being evaluated. Professional development for Readers/Writers workshop, balanced literacy was reviewed with an emphasis of the roles Gravity Goldberg and the Supervisor of ELA will play. Continuous scheduling and communication on deadlines of teacher responsibilities. Volunteerism relating to teacher evaluations vs. paid afterhours opportunities. Increase collaboration relating to decision-making process to ensure teachers are included. Showcasing our teachers at board meetings. FY17 TAB meeting dates in general will b Nov., Feb. and May. Consitency in district will food policy. Project Community Pride- Mrs. Thomas stated the new director Lisa Sprague has started. Mrs. Thomas along with Dr. Varley and Mrs. Hawkins visited the YMCA director Diane Mann to discuss the program.
