HIB Report – March

Mr. Rubano began narration of a power point presentation on the proposed 2015/16 Budget. Mr. Rubano presented program highlights, expenses, revenues and an overall tax levy increase of 2%. Mr. Rubano thanked the entire staff of the public school district for their input and preparation of the budget. Mr. DeCoursey opened the meeting for public comment inclusive of questions on the budget. Mr. Winters asked about the status of debt service. increase in miscellaneous income and the status of shared services with HPRHS on transportation. Mr. Csatlos stated that the debt service is completed in 2023, the increase is a result of a new agreement with New Horizons Day Camp and Florham Park is nearing completion of an agreement to share services with HPRHS on all regular and special education routes. Mrs. OkieKor commented on the new science standards. Mrs. Seery asked if consideration could be given to change operation of providing slots for the Integrated Preschool to accommodate residents first. Mr. Shanley asked how many computers are leased? Mr. Christ answered zero. Mr. Shanley stated that his wife works in Bergen County and they lease them. The district may want to look into that. Mr. Gruenwald asked what percentage was budgeted for teacher's raises? Mr. Rubano stated that the raise was consistent with the memorandums of agreement at 2.7% for 2015/16. The public hearing was closed.

### 6. 2015-2016 Budget

WHEREAS the Executive County Superintendent and the Executive County School Business Administrator have reviewed and approved the 2015-2016 tentative budget adopted by the board on March 16, 2015

And:

WHEREAS, the Florham Park Board of Education has concluded the required Public Hearing.

### a. TRAVEL and RELATED EXPENSE REIMBURSEMENTS

**BE IT RESOLVED**, that in accordance with Board of Education Policy and N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-7.1 provides that the board of education shall establish in the annual school budget a maximum expenditure amount that may be allotted for such travel and expense reimbursement for the 2015-2016 school year;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Florham Park School District Board of Education, in the County of Morris, New Jersey hereby establishes the school district travel maximum for the 2015-2016 school year at a sum of \$9,000; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the School Business Administrator shall track and record these costs to insure that the maximum amount is not exceeded.
