Dear Parents and Guardians,

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7C-6.6, school districts must provide parents and guardians with information on any State assessment that will be administered in the school year.

The NJDOE has not yet released the testing windows for the NJ Student Learning Assessments (NJSLA), the ACCESS test for English Language Learners, or the Dynamic Learning Maps (DLM) assessments. When those dates are released, this document will be updated accordingly on the district website.

The following information is a reference page of all state testing administered in both Brooklake Elementary School and Ridgedale Middle School for the 2020-21 school year. The following information is included:

- The subject area and grade level covered by the assessment
- The dates of the administration of the assessment (TBD)
- The time allotted to take and complete the assessment (TBD)
- Any accommodation and accessibility options available to students
- Information on how and when the students and his/her parent or guardian can access both sample questions and answers to the assessment and the student results
- Whether the assessment is required by State, Federal government or both

If a student is permitted extra time or any other accommodations by their IEP, parents/guardians should contact their guidance office for additional details on accommodations and accessibility options.

All students are required to take the assessments as per the State of New Jersey and NJ Office of Assessments.

Students taking the Algebra 1 Mathematics assessment are required to pass as part of their graduation requirements as per the State of New Jersey Office of Assessment.

The two types of testing mode are computer and paper and pencil; some computer-based assessments allow students to take the assessment using paper and pencil. Be sure to inquire about the options if your son/daughter has a medical issue that would not allow him/her to take the assessment on the computer.

'Testing time' is the maximum amount of time allotted to students to complete the assessment. Most students finish well in advance of the allotted time.

'Results available' indicates when the reports will be available to the district. The district will send out reports to parents as soon as possible. Please contact the district for further information
