

Dear Florham Park Parents/Guardians and Staff,

Due to the impending snow storm and expected hazardous conditions that will impact our area, as well as the significant cleanup that will be required after the storm has concluded, Florham Park Schools will “pivot” to the schedule listed below for Monday, February 1<sup>st</sup> and Tuesday, February 2<sup>nd</sup>:

- **Monday, February 1st:** ALL schools will be **CLOSED** for a “Snow Day!” Please find attached a fun, voluntary assignment for staff and students for Monday – [Assignment’s Video Link](#)
- **Tuesday, February 2nd:** ALL schools will “pivot” to a **100% fully remote, synchronous learning day**. All students and staff will follow the same daily schedule that is currently in place. Teachers will again provide virtual meeting information via Google Classroom and/or email. Students must participate remotely to receive attendance credit for the school day. Please contact your child's teacher if you have any questions about their classes. Should you have any concerns or special circumstances, please feel free to contact your child's school. In the event that the impact of the storm warrants an additional school closure (snow day) or an asynchronous instructional model (assignments sent out) for Tuesday, an updated communication will be sent out to the school community.

The Work-Family Connection (WFC) has informed the district that the WFC will be closed on Monday, Feb.1st and Tuesday, Feb.2nd.
