

7460 ENERGY CONSERVATION

The Florham Park Board of Education believes that one of the best ways to foster civic consciousness in its students is to demonstrate by concern and action that the district feels a responsibility for the national welfare, as well as for the needs of the individual. In this era of recurring energy crisis, the Board wishes to encourage the participation and cooperation of all members and students in a multi-faceted program of energy conservation.

Therefore, the Superintendent shall:

1. Develop rules, regulations and procedures for a continuing energy audit and implement corrective procedures. Energy uses connected with the instructional program and extracurricular activities must also be considered in this audit, but corrective measures are to be suggested and implemented as part of sections 2 and 3 of this Policy.
2. Coordinate study of energy audit findings relating to the instructional program to determine areas in which energy could be used more economically. Develop and implement procedures for practicing such economies. In addition to all regular curricular activities, this should include scheduling of special assemblies, athletic events and all other extracurricular activities.
3. Direct the appropriate staff, in consultation with students identified as having the necessary interest, to develop a program of student activities directly supporting the district's energy-conservation efforts.

In line with this Policy, the Board will direct any renovations or future construction in the district to be designed and carried out in conformity with Federal and New Jersey guidelines for conservation of energy.
